Negroni Week, the international brainchild created four years ago, now has 4,000-plus participating venues worldwide, each of them contributing a portion of negroni sales to the charity of their choice for the week of June 6-12, 2016. Campari is supporting US bars and restaurants with an extra \$10,000 for the top contributor's chosen charity fund.
